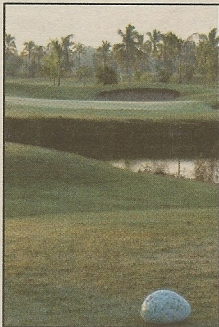


Tee Off For Hospice Mazatlan

The Fund serves Orfanatorio Mazatlan, the Salvation Army Children's Home, Fr. Tovar's Home for Boys Hogar San Pablo and Ciudad de los Ninos Orphanage.

What began as a newspaper assignment in 1987 "to photograph the children of Mexico" forever changed the

life of the Fund's founder, Donelle Manton, the children in Mazatlan's orphanages and donors from the U.S. and Canada whose contributions help feed, clothe and educate the children. The next Tres Islas Donor Mission Week will be April 5 -12. From teaching gardening and composting skills to creating sorting receiving rooms for clothes and personal hygiene items - and a beach party for the children, there is a place for everyone's skills and the Mantons extend an invitation to all.
